



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




Triathlon Roman Typical (Flat Roman Fabric Front Depicted)




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Triathlon Detail (Flat Roman Fabric Front Depicted)




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Triathlon Fabric Back Detail






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Roller 64 Detail (Flat Roman Fabric Front Depicted)




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Roller 64 Fabric Back Detail








Mounting Options





Seaming Options



Roman fabrics are designed and woven to be run "up the roll". If the shade needed is wider than the fabric width, vertical seams will be required.


Standard Offset Seam







Standard practice is to have two offset seams. A single center seam can be used as an alternative or custom seam locations can also be specified.




If your window opening is wider than the fabric width and the height is shorter than the fabric width, the fabric can be "railroaded" (run left to right).




Caution - Fabrics with patterns that are defined should not be railroaded or the result will be the pattern rotated on the Roman shade.




Shade Alignment Options




Center pattern on each shade (shades will not match side by side)



Match shades side by side by aligning tops.




Match shades side by side by using custom alignment dimensions.



Match shades side by side by aligning bottoms.



Additional Options



Returns

Standard returns will be the depth of the mounting board on outside mount and inside/outside mount shades. Custom depths can be ordered. Custom depth returns are used when the shade cannot be mounted flush with the back wall.




Banding

A decorative border which can be on the sides, bottom, and or top.



Rear Valance

A rear valance is optional on fabric front shades. They are sometimes used if the back of the shade is visible.



Lining

White, cream, self-lined and custom colors are available in standard and flame resistant linings.

Opacity options include sheer, light filtering and blackout
